University of the Philippines Manila University-wide Research Competition

"A Culture of Research: A Catalyst for Social Change": GUIDELINES

- 1. The Research Competition is open to all graduate and undergraduate courses of the University of the Philippines, Manila
- 2. There will be a separate contest for the undergraduate and graduate courses
- 3. Nominations should be made on the prescribed form signed by the student's research adviser, department chair, and College Dean.
- 4. The nomination form and other supporting documents must be submitted to the EIDR Computer Lab, 2nd Floor Damian Hall, Old Neda Complex on or before May 1, 2015.
- 5.All nominees must submit a soft copy (CD format, pdf file) of the <u>research POSTER for</u> <u>initial screening of nominees</u>. Five posters will be selected from each of the two categories (Basic Research and Applied Research) of both undergraduate and graduate courses. The top five will then be asked to submit hard and soft copies of the full research paper, following the format of Acta Medica or UP Manila Journal/PJHRD on or before May 15, 2015
- 6. Three awardees of each category (undergraduate and graduate) will be chosen to make a presentation of their research paper on **June 10, 2015**
- 7. Criteria for judging are as follows:
 - A. Impact to the community 40%

i. Applicability - The end product or the result has entrepreneurial potentials and may have commercial value

ii. Contribution to Nation & Community – The end product or result will translate into the economic improvement of a community

iii. Environmental Impact – The project helps in maintaining ecological balance

B. <u>Scientific Soundness – 40%</u>

i. Appropriateness and thoroughness of the methodology used; researchers' awareness of other approaches or theories and familiarity with scientific literature in the studied field

C. Innovativeness – 20%

i. Originality in the concept of the research

- 8. Each awardee will receive the following: Cash prize (First prize Php20,000, Second prize Php15,000, Third prize Php10,000), Certificate of Recognition, and recognition during the graduation ceremony of the University.
- 9. The winning research papers will be submitted to Acta Medica or UP Manila Journal for possible publication.

Research Poster guidelines for initial screening of the University-wide Research Competition

- All nominees must submit a soft copy (CD format, pdf file) of the research POSTER for initial screening of nominees. Five posters will be selected from each of the two categories (Basic Research and Applied Research) of both undergraduate and graduate courses. The top five will then be asked to submit hard and soft copies of the full research paper in publishable format following the format of Acta Medica or UP Manila journal/PJHRD, for second screening on May 15, 2015.
- 2. A heading should be prepared at the top of the poster indicating the abstract title, authors, and university/hospital affiliation. The title should be brief, informative and readable from two to three (2-3) meters distance. Letters should be at least one (1) inch high, and printed in blank ink.
- 3. The body of the poster should be organized as follows:
 - a. Rationale
 - b. Objective of the study
 - c. Study design
 - d. Methods
 - e. Results (include pertinent figures, graphs, tables)
 - f. Conclusions
 - g. Recommendations
- 4. The text should be kept to a minimum. It should be clear and concise. Detailed information should be provided in smaller type below the heading.
- 5. Abbreviations used should be internationally acceptable.
- 6. It should be remembered that the poster is a visual display and should be selfexplanatory, even without the author's presence. The correct use of photographs, diagrams and tables will increase the poster's effect.
- 7. The order by which the poster is to be read should be indicated clearly by means of numbers, arrows, or lines.
